## Tackling HIV and Viral Hepatitis in People who Inject drugs in Kenya

**Location:** Nairobi, Kenya (Dagoretti and Westland sub-counties)

**Target Population:** PWUD (700 reached with program services)

**Service-delivery model:** Outreach and DIC (Drop-In Centre)



Since 2013, Médecins du Monde (MdM) France has been implementing a comprehensive Harm

Reduction (HR) program, providing services to more than 700 PWUD in Kenya. Services include

NSEP (Needle-Syringe Exchange), STI testing, daily nutritional-hygiene support, HIV/HBV (Hepatitis B) testing, counseling/linkage to treatment, as well as condom distribution. The MdM Kenyan Mission began treating HCV patients in June 2016 with DAAs (direct-acting antivirals), in collaboration with Médecins San Frontières (MSF) Belgium. To date, 45 PWUD have benefited from the treatment pilot.
