
Community Mobilization: A Lever for Positive Impact

When communities are mobilized—whether people who use drugs, sex workers, or other marginalized groups—real, tangible impacts can be made in their lives. Community engagement in decision-making processes, including research, harm reduction, or peer support, has proven effective in:
